



Student Transportation      ROP requires teachers and students to follow the policies established by each school district. See *below* for additional information.

## STUDENT DRIVING POLICY

### ROP High School Students—

- ROP high school students **may not** drive other students to internships.
- ROP high school students **may not** be passengers in other ROP students' cars for the purpose of traveling to internships.
- ROP high school students **may not** drive themselves to field trips.
- ROP high school students, with a valid California Driver's License and parental permissions, may drive themselves (only) to internships.

ROP requires teachers and students to follow the specific rules established by each district. That information is available in your school's administrative office.

### ROP Adult Students—

- ROP adult students are responsible for their own transportation to field trips and internships. ROP is not liable for adult student transportation.
- If a ROP teacher needs to transport students in his/her private vehicle, the teacher must **first contact** the Student Programs Principal.
