NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Governing Board of the Liberty Union High School District at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 17, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. will invite public input regarding the draft trustee area map plan scenarios attached to this notice.

This public hearing is part of the statutory process for establishing a "by-trustee area" elections system. In a by-trustee area elections system, the Liberty Union High School District would be divided into trustee areas and each Governing Board member would be elected by only the registered voters in the particular trustee area where the Governing Board member resides. The Governing Board is currently elected using an at-large elections system, in which all Governing Board members are elected by voters of the entire District. At two previous public hearings, the District's demographer received input into the creation of draft trustee area map plan scenarios which were subsequently shared with the public at a community input meeting held on November 10, 2021. By law, the District must conduct at least two public hearings on the map plans prior to selecting a final by-trustee area election map plan for the election of Governing Board members commencing in November of 2022. En un sistema de elecciones por áreas administradoras, el Distrito Liberty Union High School se dividiría en áreas administradoras y cada miembro de la Junta Directiva sería elegido sólo por los votantes registrados en el área administradora particular donde reside el miembro de la Junta Directiva. La Junta Directiva se elige actualmente mediante un sistema de elecciones generales, en el que todos los miembros de la Junta Directiva son elegidos por votantes de todo el Distrito Liberty Union High School. En las dos audiencias públicas anteriores, el demógrafo del distrito recibió información para la creación de escenarios del plan del mapa de las áreas administradoras que posteriormente se compartió con el público en la reunión de opinión de la comunidad que se llevaron a cabo el 10 de noviembre de 2021. Por ley, el Distrito debe llevar a cabo al menos dos audiencias públicas sobre los planes del mapa antes de seleccionar un plan definitivo del mapa de elecciones de las áreas administradoras, para la elección de los miembros de la Junta Directiva a partir de noviembre de 2022. 1. Notice is hereby given that the governing board ("Board") of the West Contra Costa Unified School District ("District")...

2. Electronic bids must be uploaded directly to the online bidding platform...

3. The Project consists of the addition and replacement of cameras to an existing Genetec Security Overcast System.

4. All bids shall be on the form provided by the District. Each bid must conform and be responsive to all pertinent Contract Documents...

5. To bid on this project, the Bidder is required to possess one or more of the following State of California Contractor Licenses: C-1 and/or B.

The Bidder's Contract must be active and in good standing at the time of the bid opening and must remain so throughout the term of the Contract.

6. As a security for its bid, each bidder shall provide with its bid form: a bid bond issued by an admitted surety in California...

7. The successful Bidder shall be required to furnish a 10% Performance Bond and a 100% Payment Bond if it is awarded the contract for the Project.

8. The successful Bidder may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the District to ensure performance under the Contract...

9. The successful Bidder and its subcontractors shall pay all workers on the Project not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevalence for high-tide and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California...

10. The District requires 9% retention. 11. A bid-awards meeting will be held at Richmond High School located at 170 2nd Street, Richmond, CA 94681 on Wednesday, November 17, 2021...

12. Contract Documents may be obtained through eProcure on or after November 1, 2021. Contractors will be required to pay (1) \$40 for Contract Documents at the time of pickup of bid opening...

13. The District's Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids and/or waive any irregularity in any bid received. If the District awards the Contract, the security of successful bidder shall be returned within sixty (60) days from the time the award is made...

14. The District shall award the Contract, if it awards it at all, to the lowest responsible bidder based on the Total Base Bid amount only.
