I hope this note finds you well! We received confirmation today that the current Shelter-In-Place in the Bay Area is being extended through May 31st, with the relaxing of a few restrictions. The new order goes into effect May 4th. The extension is being put in place to ensure that we do not lose the progress we have achieved and to remember that the virus is still active in our community. The new order does introduce the easing of some specific restrictions for lower-risk activities, but schools are not impacted by the easing of those restrictions. The orders do not change any plans for our agency for the month of May, as our buildings remain closed, and distance learning for students will continue through the end of the school year.
