The Contra Costa Board of Education

How is the Board organized?

The Contra Costa County Board of Education is the elected Board of Education for the County of Contra Costa. The Board of Education consists of five members elected by trustee districts to staggered four-year terms. Each Board member represents the County Office of Education as a whole, but must be a registered voter in their trustee area. In accordance with the California Education Code and certain other rules and laws, the Contra Costa County Board of Education serves as the governing board for the juvenile court schools operated by the County Office of Education.

What does the Board do?

The Board establishes educational policies for the programs administered by the County Office of Education. These programs include Special Education, Court and Community Schools, and Career Development. The Board also:

- Establishes educational policies for the programs administered by the CCCOE
- Approves curriculum for CCCOE programs
- Approves COE budgets
- Hears appeals on charter schools, interdistrict transfer disputes, and expulsion cases
- Acts as the County Committee on School District Organization, which reviews changes in school district boundaries.
