

Partnership Responsibilities

National University

- Provides leadership support for the CCCOE PASC program to help align instruction with the CAPEs
- Supports program faculty with updates from National University's leadership
- Provides guidance for candidates wishing to obtain units for their participation in the CCCOE Preliminary Administrative Services Credential program
- Provides resources, guidance, and mentoring for students wishing to obtain their Masters of Arts through the CCCOE PASC Program and National University partnership
- Provides continuity of instructional practices between PASC faculty and National faculty members
- Facilitates the sharing of research and new information about exemplary leadership practices

Contra Costa County School Districts' Leadership

- Recruit future leaders for participation in the PASC program
- Advertise and share information with district and site staff to inform future candidates of program opportunities
- Provide guidance in identification of exemplary leaders to serve as district/site supervisors for candidates
- Support collaboration between candidates and site/district supervisors to participate in a broad spectrum of leadership opportunities for their fieldwork requirements
- Support district/site leaders who serve as district/site supervisors for candidates by providing research based professional development, acquiring resources, as needed, and encouraging their mentorship
