Marchus recently had a word of the month assembly and craft fair. Principal Richards has been spending time getting to know students. Staff recently had a Renaissance training. Winter break is coming soon.</p>
<p>5.0 SSC Elections and Chairperson Vote</p>	<p>The SSC will have the following membership, either in the second year of their term or newly elected: Stephanie Richards, Principal Melanie Santos, Teacher Christie Quinn, Classified/Other Staff Jolene Matthews, Parent Hunter Holmes, Student Tiffani Mason, Community Member There is no quorum, so a chairperson cannot be elected. That will be done at the next SSC.</p>
<p>6.0 SSC Training</p>	<p>Ms. Lecy provided training to the SSC. She provided information about the CDE guidelines for membership meetings. She provided information about the Greene Act and Roberts Rules of Order. She provided information about the documents the SSC reviews, and the additional committees the SSC may function as. She provided resources on the SSC handbook, bylaws, and the CDE guidelines. Trustee Butler had a question about Marchus' grade levels. Marchus is a K-12 school. The SSC follows the secondary composition to incorporate the student voice at the secondary grade levels.</p>
<p>7.0 Title 1 Parent Engagement Policy</p>	<p>Principal Richards presented a draft of the policy. Ms. Lecy will confirm ELAC language and let Principal Richards know. The September 30th date will remain. Trustee Butler asked about the term, "guardian" and its usage. The SSC discussed and recommended including that term.</p>

8.0 School-Parent Compact	<p>Principal Richards reviewed the draft school-parent compact.</p> <p>Ms. Matthews discussed the importance of school photos and shared an idea for a school yearbook.</p> <p>The SSC discussed making some changes to the language and multiple terms for adults in students' lives.</p> <p>Principal Richards will make updates to the policy and bring the new version to the next SSC meeting for approval. SSC members should send feedback on the document between now and then.</p>
9.0 Overview of the SPSA	<p>Ms. Lecy gave an overview of the SPSA document including the background, data, goals, and expenditures. Principal Richards discussed Marchus' goals for social-emotional, academics, and parent engagement. She discussed making the goals more specific for the next SPSA.</p> <p>Trustee Butler provided feedback that some of the goal language seems like two goals in one, and that the goals could be more specific and measurable.</p> <p>Trustee Butler inquired about the smaller amount of funding for Marchus versus other county schools. Ms. Lecy discussed that Title 1 funds come to the county centrally and then are allocated to the sites based on several factors including enrollment. Marchus is a small PED program that districts fund when they place students at Marchus, so it has other funding streams compared to schools like Golden Gate or Mt. McKinley who may need more Title 1 funds.</p> <p>SSC members will review the SPSA and provide feedback to Principal in advance of the next SSC meeting.</p>
