8.0 Overview of Feedback for New SPSA	Ms. Richards shared the new goals:  Goal One: By June 2024, alternatives to suspensions will support a 50% decrease in out of school suspensions. Goal Two: By June 2024, Teachers/Instructional Staff will assess their students on Renaissance STAR Math and Reading at least 3 times during the school year and in turn utilize their assessment data to plan and deliver instruction both whole-group and in small groups/individually. Goal Three: By June 2024 we will increase caregiver involvement by decreasing obstacles that exist due caregivers and families living different distances and varied access to transportation to Marchus Ms. Frias suggested a change to the language of goal three, to add work to increase instead of we will increase. Group was in agreement.  Ms. Richards proposed changing the amount of Title one money allocation. The group agreed to decrease the amount for professional consult from 8,000-6,000 and increase allocation in books and supplies from 1,000-
