<p>4.0 2023-2024 School Year Update</p>	<p><b>Principal Richards shared that Marchus is at its highest enrollment in several years. The school is approaching the end of the semester.</b></p>
<p>5.0 SPSA and Safety Plan Implementation Update</p>	<p><b>Principal Richards shared that the safety plan is being implemented. Staff have been comparing the implementation of the safety plan with the recent PREPaRE training. For the SPSA, Marchus has been focusing on data to drive individual student supports.</b></p>
<p>6.0 LCAP Feedback</p>	<p><b>Ms. Lecy explained what the LCAP is, the goals, and how it relates to funding and SPSAs.
