

TIMELINE SCENARIOS FOR IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION

Contra Costa Health Services (CCHS)
Contra Costa County Office of Education (CCCOE)

TK-6TH GRADE GENERAL EDUCATION



In-person instruction in stable groups of no more than 14 students and 2 adults



Must have waiver approval from CCHS and California Department of Public Health (CDPH)

Waivers can be submitted while Contra Costa is in PURPLE status



All staff should be tested at least once every 2 months

STUDENTS NEEDING TARGETED, SPECIALIZED SUPPORT



In-person support services and instruction in stable groups of no more than 14 students and 2 adults



School/district determines eligible population

Do not need waiver or change in color/monitoring status



Surveillance testing of staff recommended but not required

TK-12TH GRADE GENERAL EDUCATION



In-person instruction using small, stable cohorts as much as practicable (not required to be cohorts of 14 students and 2 adults maximum.)



Can only resume after Contra Costa County has been out of purple status/monitoring list for 14 days (school/district decision)



Surveillance testing of staff recommended but not required
