#### 7.4.1 Consider options for filling the vacant seat for Trustee Area 2

The seat of Trustee Area 2 became vacant on March 12, 2014 due to an unexpected event. The term was due to expire on November 27, 2014. The regular election to fill the seat is November 4, 2014. If the vacancy had occurred within 4 months of the end of the term, the seat would have remained vacant until the regularly scheduled election in November. The County Board of Education has 60 days to fill the vacancy by appointment or election. Approximate cost of a special election would be \$328,800. If the County Board of Education decides to fill the vacancy by appointment, Board Bylaw 9221(a) sets forth the process the County Board of Education uses to advertise for and make a provisional appointment. The person who fills the vacancy by appointment will serve out the remainder of the unexpired term, until November 2014. Since the seat will be open for election to a full term in November, the filing deadline for candidates is August 8, 2014. If the incumbent (appointee) does not file for candidacy, the filing deadline is extended to August 13, 2014.
