On behalf of the Board, Hearing Facilitator Lindy Khan announced that the Contra Costa Board of Education voted 5-0-0 to approve the interdistrict attendance transfer appeal of Student A-06/10/15 based upon Contra Costa County Office of Education Administrative Regulation 5200, G 3.1-the student's psychological or physical well-being, and Student B-06/10/15 based upon Contra Costa County Office of Education Administrative Regulation 5200, G 3.5-a severe and demonstrated hardship to parents/guardians which could affect the student's success in school.
