Trustee Butler requested updated information on Gamut and where we are in the process for accessing policies.

Michelle Kiernan reported the current policy access and the benefits of obtaining CSBA's Gamut Policy Plus, where Gamut would host our policies and users could search all policies and live links to additional information.

Superintendent Mackey expressed interest in moving forward with Gamut Policy Plus.

Trustee Butler mentioned Gamut's Covid-19 policies.

The group will continue to check Gamut for County Office Covid-19 policies.

After Covid-19 transition period, Lynn Mackey and Bill Clark will put together a list of Board Policies (BPs) and Superintendent Policies for review.

4.3 Review of Board Policies 0000s- Philosophy, Goals and General Objectives

BP 0420.4- Authorization of County Charter Schools

- 1. Under "Denial of Petition", Negative Certification; denial based on negative certification requires comparison to Ed Code 1240 and FCMAT.Research needed regarding charter appeal or renewal based on fiscal impact.
- 2. Under Memoranda of Understanding, Currently, we only review when there is a material revision. Review this paragraph
 - Next Steps for 0420.4
 - o Bring back 0420.4 on next agenda
 - o Research fiscal impact and negative certification Under Denial of Petition (8)
 - o Review language under Memoranda of understanding
 - o Review language under Material Revisions to an Authorized Charter
 - Proposed
 - Remove "transcribed" on Page 6 (paragraph beginning with "The hearing shall be...")

BP 0420.41- Oversight of County Charter Schools

- 1. Under Designated Charter School Contact; Requires County Board or representative to inspect or observe each charter school under it's authority at least once each year. Bill Clark recommended looking into Ed Code to confirm the appropriate wording.
- 2. Proposed language in 3rd paragraph, 2nd sentence, "At least once a year, the County Board or it's designated representative shall visit...."

BP 0420.42- Renewal of County Charter Schools

- 1. Under Renewal of County Charter Schools, 3rd paragraph; Research specific requirements for submitting petitions
- 2. Under Criteria for Granting or Denying Renewal, 2nd paragraph; Check into "Charter renewal shall not be denied based on fiscal impact". Renewal uses same criteria as petition.
- 3. Under page 2, 2nd & 3rd paragraphs; Considering performance, check on accuracy. Measures include new criteria, state-wide data. What determines a measure of academic achievement?
- 4. Under page 2, paragraph starting with "Following such..", Review the term "Shall be granted for a period of five years"
- 5. Under page 2, paragraph starting with "Alternatively,...", Change "...for a period of five to seven years" to "...for a period not to exceed five years"
